Map data file format

Most customers request map data to be supplied optimised for use in Memory-Map using the Memory-Map QuickChart™ format. Map data can also be supplied in raw image format or exported from Memory-Map for use in other applications. Using Memory-Map QuickChart optimised data means the map data is precisely georeferenced for use in Memory-Map and can benefit from the high performance image manipulation algorithms built into Memory-Map software to help move large map images quickly and easily across the screen even on a Pocket PC.

Optional Memory-Map software modules:

Memory-Map Tracking - real-time tracking of your Memory-Map closed user group using PCs, Pocket PCs, Phones or GPS tracking units. Tracked objects can be viewed using Memory-Map software on PC or Pocket PC as well as web browser based map viewer.

Memory-Map SDK - a suite of tools to enable Memory-Map software to be integrated into your own software applications.

Memory-Map AIS - Add on AIS collision avoidance software for marine users

Memory-Map Weather Radar - View weather radar images on your Pocket PC or Smartphone.
